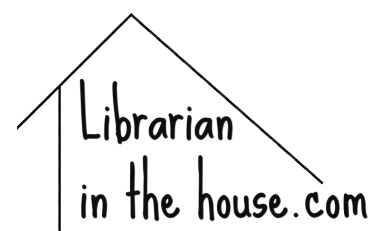

Gall, Chris	<i>Dinotrux</i> series (our fave is <i>Dinotrux Dig the Beach</i>), <i>The Ninjabread Man</i>	Toddler-early elementary
Gannett, Ruth Stiles	<i>My Father's Dragon</i> (chapter book trilogy)	Older preschoolers ready for chapter books-mid elementary
Geisert, Arthur	(primarily wordless books) <i>Hogwash, Lights Out, Thunderstorm</i>	Preschool-elementary
Gerstein, Mordicai	<i>The Night World, The Man Who Walked Between the Towers</i> (Caldecott medal)	Early elementary
Gibbons, Gail	Prolific nonfiction writer	Preschool-early elementary
Grahame, Kenneth	(chapter/short stories) <i>The Reluctant Dragon, The Wind in the Willows</i>	Elementary
Gravett, Emily	<i>Tidy, The Rabbit Problem, Bear & Hare series, Monkey & Me, Wolves, Little Mouse's Big Book of Fears</i>	Toddler- elementary
Grogan, John	<i>Marley</i> series	Preschool-early elementary
Guarino, Deborah	<i>Is Your Mama a Llama?</i>	Baby-preschool
